**ATC Advisory:
Renewal Applications for Retailers, Wholesalers & Manufacturers Extended
Permits Expiring December 31, 2021 & January 31, 2022**

Dear Permit holders,

In consideration of the disruption caused by the holidays, USPS delays, and the surge in coronavirus cases, an extension will be granted to all permit holders currently holding a valid permit expiring on December 31, 2021, or January 31, 2022. If a renewal application has been submitted to the ATC, said licenses will be granted an extension to February 28, 2022, or until such time a decision has been made on the application. This extension authorizes permit holders to operate in good standing under a valid permit. All licensed retailers may continue to purchase alcoholic beverages and tobacco products from these manufacturers and/or tobacco wholesale dealers until otherwise notified. Wholesalers and manufactures may also continue to sell to these permittees during this grace period as allowed under the law.
