ALCOHOL DELIVERY ADVISORY

To all grocery store delivery and alcohol delivery personnel:

After careful review of Act No. 436 of the 2019 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature the Agency is issuing this statement in order to provide additional clarity. Act 436 requires all retailers and permittees to keep a record of all deliveries of alcoholic beverages for a period of at least two years from the date of delivery. The record of the deliveries shall include, among other information, the name, date of birth, and signature of the person that received the delivery.

At the time of the delivery the permittee or permittee employees are required to use a real-time age verification system. This verification system can be an application that is downloaded on a handheld device, including a cellular phone. Additionally, the verification system must be capable of saving and storing all required delivery information. The Agency should be notified of which verification system is selected for use. The Agency should be updated if there is a change in selected verification system.
